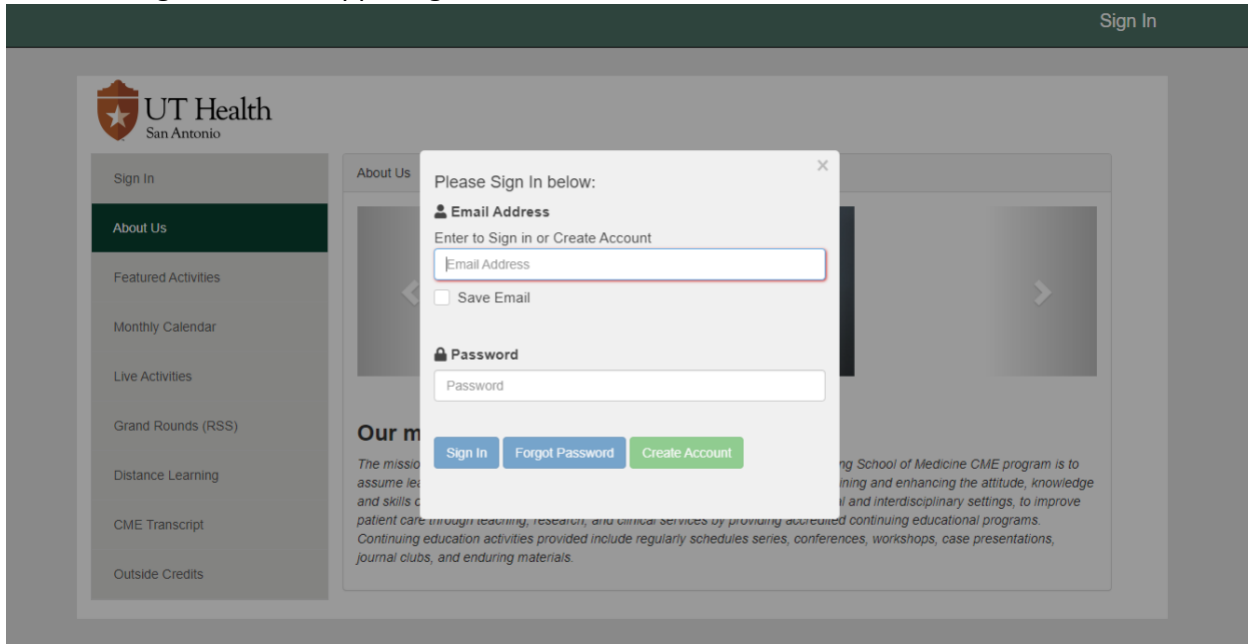
About Us

Our mission

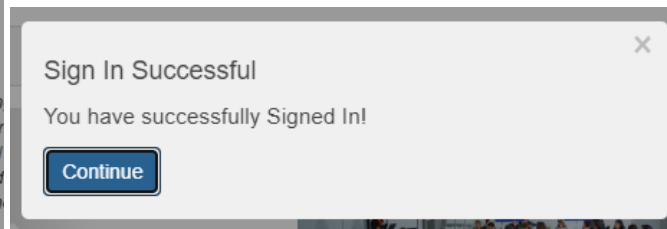

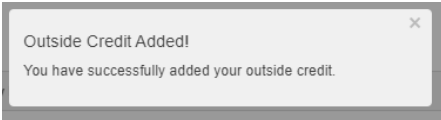
- Click on **Outside Credits** from the left side menu. This will take you to the Outside Credits page.
