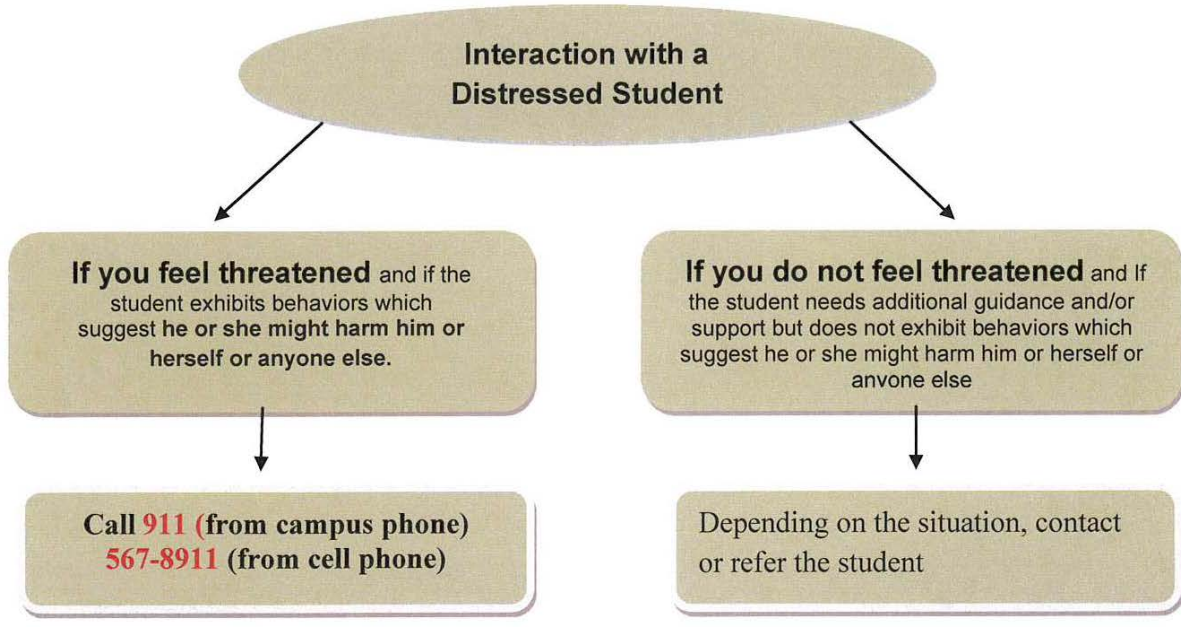


## Crisis Response Quick Reference
